Elenchus of Biblica 2005 unbinding isaac takes readers on a trek of discovery for our times into the binding of isaac story nineteenth century danish philosopher søren kierkegaard viewed the story as teaching suspension of ethics for the sake of faith and subsequent jewish thinkers developed this idea as a cornerstone of their religious worldview aaron koller examines and critiques kierkegaard s perspective and later incarnations of it on textual religious and ethical grounds he also explores the current of criticism of abraham in jewish thought from ancient poems and midrashim to contemporary israel narratives as well as jewish responses to the akedah over the generations finally bringing together these multiple strands of thought along with modern knowledge of human sacrifice in the phoenician world koller offers an original reading of the akedah the biblical god would like to want child sacrifice because it is in fact a remarkable display of devotion but more than that he does not want child sacrifice because it would violate the child s autonomy thus the high point in the drama is not the binding of isaac but the moment when abraham is told to release him the torah does not allow child sacrifice though by contrast some of israel s neighbors viewed it as a religiously inspiring act the binding of isaac teaches us that an authentically religious act cannot be done through the harm of another human being

Nietzsche, Soloveitchik and Contemporary Jewish Philosophy 2018-06-28 the present volume is a translation of rabbi joseph b soloveitchik s classic essay u vikkashtem mi sham drafted in the 1940 s as a companion to his earlier treatise halakhic man this powerful and wide ranging work was published in hebrew only in 1978 drawing its title from deuteronomy 4 29 and from there you shall seek the lord your god and you shall find him if you search for him with all of your heart and all of your soul and framed by the evocative metaphors of the song of songs the essay charts the individual s search for god a quest which culminates in the stage of devekut cleaving to him the human being initially seeks god by examining the natural and spiritual worlds but this search fails hence god must reveal himself and express his will rabbi soloveitchik explicates the contrast between these two different modes of experiencing the divine the natural consciousness marked by freedom and creativity and the revelational consciousness marked by compulsion and discipline the remainder of the work elaborates on this dialectic exploring such themes as the imitation of god devekut mercy and justice trust and fear love and awe the rule of intellect elevation of the body the perpetuity of god s word and creation and revelation and from there you shall seek is rabbi soloveitchik s fullest and most elaborate examination of religious consciousness and the dynamics of religious experience its presentation of the challenging interplay between cultural creativity religious practice and spiritual quest is sure to enrich the contemporary reader book jacket
