variety of approaches having been tested and integrated in residential and community settings

from 2007 through 2017 to determine the percent of facilities having the characteristics of higher quality we analyzed the percent by state and over time we found improvements between 2007 and 2017 on most measures but performance on several measures remained low most programs reported providing evidence based behavioral therapies half or fewer facilities offered medications for opioid use disorder mental health assessments testing for hepatitis c hiv and sexually transmitted diseases self help groups employment assistance and transportation assistance there was significant state level variation across the measures
