*Proceedings ...* 1893 gaia a new look at life on earth may continue to divide opinion but nobody can deny that the book offers a powerful insight into the creative thinking of its author james e lovelock published in 1979 gaia offered a radically new hypothesis the earth lovelock argued is a living entity together the planet and all its separate living organisms form a single self regulating body sustaining life and helping it evolve through time lovelock sees humans as no more special than other elements of the planet railing against the once widely held belief that the good of mankind is the only thing that matters despite being seen as radical and even idiotic on its publication a version of lovelock s viewpoint has found resonance in contemporary debates about the environment and climate and has now broadly come to be accepted by modern thinkers as man s effects on the climate become increasingly extreme more and more elements of the earth s self regulation seem to be unveiled forcing scientists to ask how far the planet might be able to go in order self regulate effectively indeed despite its far fetched elements lovelock s gaia thesis seems to ring more convincingly today than ever before that it does is largely a result of the critical thinking skills that allowed lovelock to produce novel explanations for existing evidence and above all to connect existing fragments of evidence together in new ways

Polk** 1969 at the outbreak of war in 1861 russell m tuttle was a junior at the university of rochester inspired by the death of a friend and urged by classmates and an influential professor he enlisted with the 107th regiment new york volunteers in august 1862 during the war he saw action in maryland virginia and tennessee took part in the siege of atlanta and the march to the sea and returned through the carolinas on his march home in the waning days of conflict an orderly sergeant at muster he achieved the rank of captain before discharge at war's end sensitive introspective and literate tuttle kept a journal of those bloody years between

1861 and 1865 previously unpublished and only recently discovered the journal tells the story of a young man driven to war by principle and the resulting struggle of loneliness bloodshed self preservation and hope that often defines soldiers this volume contains the text of Tuttle's journal along with 38 photographs rare period illustrations maps and an index of names and locations appendices include an obituary of Tuttle an overview of the 107th and an 1861 description of the effects of disease on an army in the field

Lee commander of the Army of Northern Virginia had come to embody the Confederate cause Grant knew as much and decided to take the field with the Potomac Army he ordered his subordinates to forgo efforts to capture Richmond in favor of annihilating Lee's command Grant's directive to Meade was straightforward where Lee goes there you will go also Lee and Grant would come to symbolize the armies they led when the spring 1864 campaign began in Northern Virginia in the wilderness on May 5 what followed was a desperate bloody death match that ran through the long siege of Richmond and Petersburg before finally ending at Appomattox Court House eleven months later but at what cost along the way this book recounts some of the most famous episodes and compelling human dramas from the marquee matchup of the Civil War these expanded and revised essays also commemorate a decade of emerging Civil War a best of collection on the Overland Campaign the Siege of Petersburg and the Confederate Surrender at Appomattox
