rizzo fu il primo a studiare il teatro greco di siracusa la prima versione dell'opera risale al 1916 quando l'archeologo partecipò vincendolo ad un concorso bandito dall'accademia dei lincei il concorso richiedeva una monografia che illustri sotto ogni aspetto e completamente il teatro greco di siracusa l'opera venne pubblicata solo nel 1923 al termine della prima guerra mondiale nella stessa forma con cui aveva vinto il concorso sette anni prima l'opera presenta due capitoli introduttivi nei quali vengono riportate tutte le notizie rimaste negli scritti antichi riguardanti il monumento la trattazione archeologica vera e propria comincia al terzo capitolo dove l'autore descrive ed analizza le tre parti principali del teatro il koilon l'orchestra la scena per ognuna di esse vengono indicati gli elementi riferibili alle tre fasi della loro vita quella classica quella ellenistica e quella romana ai tre capitoli precedentemente elencati si aggiungono 11 tavole e 65 disegni a penna e in foto

this volume brings together archeologists art historians philologists literary scholars political scientists and historians to articulate the ways in which western greek theater was distinct from that of the greek mainland and at the same time to investigate how the two traditions interacted the chapters intersect and build on each other in their pursuit of a number of shared questions and themes the place of theater in the cultural life of sicilian and south italian colonial cities theater as a method of cultural self identification shared mythological themes in performance texts and theatrical vase painting and the reflection and analysis of sicilian and south italian theater in the work of athenian philosophers and playwrights together the essays explore central problems in the study of western greek theater by gathering a number of different perspectives and methods this volume offers the first wide ranging examination of this hitherto neglected history

in theatre in ancient greek society the author examines the social setting and function of ancient greek theatre through the thousand years of its performance history instead of using written sources which were intended only for a small educated section of the population he draws most of his evidence from a wide range of archaeological material from cheap mass produced vases and figurines to elegant silverware produced for the dining tables of the wealthy this is the first study examining the function and impact of the theatre in ancient greek society by employing an archaeological approach

this is the second volume of a social and economic history of the theatre to 300 bc and focuses exclusively on theatre culture in attica rural dionysia and the rest of the greek world it presents and discusses in detail all the documentary and material evidence for theatre culture and dramatic production from the first two centuries of theatre history namely the period c 500 to c 300 bc the traditional assumption is laid to rest that theatre was an exclusively or primarily athenian institution with the inclusion of all sources of information for theatrical performances in twenty two deme sites and over one hundred and twenty independent greek and some non greek cities all texts are translated and made accessible to non specialists and specialists alike the volume will be a fundamental work of reference for all classicists and theatre historians interested in ancient theatre and its wider historical contexts

age old scholarly dogma holds that the death of serious theatre went hand in hand with the death of the city state and that the fourth century bc ushered in an era of theatrical mediocrity offering shallow entertainment to a depoliticised citizenry the traditional view of fourth century culture is encouraged and sustained by the absence of dramatic texts in anything more than fragments until recently little attention was paid to an enormous array of non literary evidence attesting not only the sustained vibrancy of theatrical culture but a huge expansion of theatre throughout and even beyond the greek world epigraphic historiographic iconographic and archaeological evidence indicates that the fourth century bc was an age of exponential growth in theatre it saw the construction of permanent stone theatres across and beyond the mediterranean world the addition of theatrical events to existing festivals the creation of entirely new contexts for drama and vast investment both public and private in all areas of what was rapidly becoming a major industry this is the first book to explore all the evidence for fourth century ancient theatre its architecture drama dissemination staging reception politics social impact finance and memorialisation
