galaxies form a physically homogeneous family has been brushed up once more results of these and other parallel studies look rather promising and point to suture part of the dichotomy between ellipticals and disk galaxies which had become popular in the early eighties owing to dynamical arguments at the same time it appears more and more clear that besides the usual genetic varieties of galaxies products of environmental evolution must also be contemplated in building our modern picture of the reign of galaxies the above considerations prompted us to solicit prof this book
