It is a common mistake to think that the only way to reduce risk is to eliminate the hazard. In fact, risk is a function of both the hazard and the exposure to it. Therefore, it is often more effective to control the exposure to the hazard than to eliminate the hazard itself. This is the principle of the hierarchy of controls, which is a systematic approach to risk management. The hierarchy of controls consists of five levels, from most effective to least effective: elimination, substitution, engineering controls, administrative controls, and personal protective equipment (PPE). The goal is to move from the least effective level to the most effective level.
