techniques in simulation based planning and scheduling supplemental course material is also available on line third edition the new third edition adds sections on randomness in simulation model debugging and monte carlo simulation in addition the coverage of animation input analysis and output analysis has been significantly expanded there is a new appendix on simulation based scheduling end of chapter problems have been improved and expanded and we have incorporated many reader suggestions we have reorganized the material for improved flow and have updates throughout the book for many of the new simio features recently added a new format better supports our e book users and a new publisher supports significant cost reduction for our readers
