being the autobiography of a noble dog i love dogs who does not it is a natural feeling to love those who love us and dogs were always fond of me this attachment of mine to the canine family in general and their affection towards myself have induced me like the vizier in the arabian nights of happy memory to devote some time to the study of their language its idiom is not so difficult as many would suppose there is a simplicity about it that often shames the dialects of man which have been so altered and refined that we discover people often saying one thing when they mean exactly the reverse nothing of the sort is visible in the great canine tongue whether the tone in which it is uttered be gruff or polished sharp or insinuating it is at least sincere mankind would often be puzzled how to use it like many others its meaning is assisted by gestures of the body and above all by the expression of the eye if ever language had its seat in that organ as phrenologists pretend it lies in the eye of the dog yet a good portion finds its way to his tail the motion of that eloquent member is full of meaning there is the slow wag of anger the gentle wag of contentment the brisker wag of joy and what can be more mutely expressive than the limp states of sorrow humility and fear if the tongue of the dog present such distinctive traits the qualities of the animal himself are not less striking although the dispositions of dogs are as various as their forms although education connections the society they keep have all their influence to the credit of their name be it said a dog never sullies his mouth with an untruth his emotions of pleasure are genuine never forced his grief is not the semblance of woe but comes from the heart his devotion is unmixed with other feelings it is single unselfish profound prosperity affects it not adversity cannot make it swerve ingratitude that saddest of human vices is unknown to the dog he does not forget past favours but when attached by benefits received his love endures through life but i shall have never done with reciting the praises of this noble animal the subject is inexhaustible my purpose now has narrower limits from the archives of the city of caneville i lately drew the materials of a bear s biography from the same source i now derive my adventures of a dog my task has been less that of a composer than a translator for a feline editoress a miss minette gattina had already performed her part this latter animal appears however to have been so learned a cat one may say so deep a puss that she had furnished more notes than there was original matter another peculiarity which distinguished her labours was the obscurity of her style i call it a peculiarity and not a defect because i am not quite certain whether the difficulty of getting at her meaning lay in her mode of expressing herself or my deficiency in the delicacies of her language i think myself a tolerable linguist yet have too great a respect for puss to say that any fault is attributable to her the same feeling

has naturally made me careful in rendering those portions which were exclusively her own i have preferred letting her say little to allowing her to express anything she did not intend her notes which doubtless drew many a purr of approval from her own breast and many a wag of approbation from the tails of her choice acquaintance i have preferred leaving out altogether and i have so curtailed the labours of her paw and the workings of her brain as to condense into half a dozen pages her little volume of introduction the autobiography itself most luckily required no alteration it is the work of a simple mind detailing the events of a simple but not uneventful life whether i have succeeded in conveying to my readers intelligence the impression which this dog s adventures made on mine they alone can decide

# A Trained Dog Is a Good Dog

a dog can be a wonderful companion with enormous affection for you and your family his keen senses and alertness can provide you with much needed protection but it is important to remember that you must be prepared to care for your pet for the next twelve or more years like a child it will depend on you not only for its health and well being but also for dedicated training in order to become a friendly well mannered dog that is a pleasure for you and others it must also be remembered that we do not live in a dogs world but that our dogs are the ones who must learn to live in a human world it is therefore our responsibility to adequately prepare them for the unfamiliar environment in which we place them society does not punish a child for pulling a dogs tail but will punish the dog for biting that child before a handler can train his dog he must understand what is involved in the training process he needs to understand what is required from him and the dog in each part of each of the different obedience exercises he must be able to teach his dog what it is expected to know help it as much as possible and make it as easy as possible for the dog he needs to know about positive reinforcement in order to get the targeted behavior to recur and to reward good behavior above all he needs to know when and how much to praise and what to do when the dog is not performing a task it was taught all this he cannot learn during the relatively short time he spends each week with the instructor at the club six days a week he is alone at home with his dog and needs to continue to build on the training he received at the club he needs to remember the seguence of training steps and how to break them up into the small component parts to be mastered by the dog and when he becomes confused he needs help or notes to refer to this is what i had in mind when i decided to write these notes on basic dog obedience training there are many basic training methods from clicker training to the more traditional methods that can be used to train a dog for obedience work the perfect training method does not exist otherwise we would all have had copies made and used on our dogs no we are all learning and improving i have adopted an eclectic approach to dog trainingthat is i have over many years studied different training methods and selected from them what will work for most dogs at times however i may use a combination of these methods or i may shift from one method to another depending on the training need or exercise what is very important to me is that the reader must not only know about the best methods of teaching dogs today but must understand why a dog behaves the way it does above all it must be remembered that dog training must be fun for both dog and trainer most dog owners do not ask much of their dogs they ask only that the dogs obey some basic commands and that they are well behaved at home and in public that is why all dogs should at least do the canine good citizen test i hope my notes will add to your knowledge of basic dog obedience training and that your trained dog will bring much joy to you and your family jan meyer ba sa med dcrt us hp mt

on a warm spring day in 2008 connie newcomb walked into a class for show dog handlers with a borderline crazy man hating chihuahua puppy named broadway and absolutely no idea of what to do from that day on her life would never be the same she has come along way since then and what a trip it s been in february 2012 newcomb did make it to the prestigious westminster kennel club dog show in new york city though not in the way she ever expected for anyone who tunes in the popular annual broadcast offers a glimpse of the best of the best among canines but a closer look behind the scenes at what it takes to get there reveals a society with its own language hierarchy and complex traditions newcomb was so fascinated by what she saw and heard that she recorded the entire journey in dog show confidential sneaking in the back door of westminster over countless weekends on the dog show circuit what newcomb witnessed firsthand topped anything she could have imagined she would what began as an innocent attempt to fill her empty nest swiftly turned into a rollicking ride that brought her face to face with a host of indelible characters canine and human including the infamous patty hearst and her award winning french bulldogs each day brought new adventures and new obstacles as well as new members to her ever expanding pack of tiny dogs and it s all unleashed in this laugh out loud book does it recall the film best in show you bet it does before getting swept up in the dog show world newcomb never thought that she would one day appear on television good day new york with her herniated hell bitch or write a book like dog show confidential sure there are plenty of dog books out there many of them heartrending memoirs by pet lovers or how to manuals on raising or training dogs but there is no book about dogs and dog shows written by a true do it yourself insider rather than a journalist see what it takes to really understand the dog show world and walk the green carpet under the westminster banner at madison square garden follow the adventures of broadway aka kate carl leeloo the supreme being gypsy jack rocky and yoshi the pack master along

with an assortment of characters you just can t make up today newcomb spends most of her time attending dog shows she currently owns and handles four champion chihuahuas including rocky an award of merit winner at westminster 2010 connie s newest champion bill is ranked among the top five grand champion point winners in pennsylvania and her japanese chin yoshi was featured in kate lacey s show dogs a photographic breed guide connie lives in eastern pennsylvania with eight chihuahuas one japanese chin a leggy mutt named penny lane and her very patient husband jim this is her first book for more on newcomb s adventures please check out the website at dogshowconfidential com
