top is perceived because the men in the surveys and interviews were guaranteed anonymity they talk in a candid and uncensored way about their daily interactions with women bosses employees and colleagues as well as what they see as the most common forces of friction and misunderstanding between men and women at work among the subjects the male factor tackles are how men with rare exception view almost any emotional display as a sign that the person can no longer think clearly as well as what they perceive to be emotion in the first place it s not just crying why certain trendy clothes that women wear may create a career sabotaging land mine in terms of how male colleagues perceive them the unintentional signals that can change a man s perception of a woman from assertive and competent to difficult women will likely be surprised even shocked by these revelations some may find them challenging yet what they will gain is an invaluable understanding of how their male bosses colleagues subordinates and customers react to a host of situations as well as the ability to correct common misperceptions the male factor offers a unique road map to what men in the workplace are thinking allowing women the opportunity to decide for themselves how to use the insights feldhahn reveals
