became his champion along the way rodrigo s musical voice developed and matured as his horizons widened suárez pajares and clark present a definitive account of the making of rodrigo s celebrated guitar concerto even as they capture the breadth of rodrigo s compositional output from solo works for piano and guitar through chamber music and vocal works to concertos and orchestral pieces as they demonstrate rodrigo s music is unmistakably spanish but with his own unique accent rodrigo s life and career spanned a period of great tumult in spain and he had to navigate strong shifting political and cultural currents before during and after franco an authoritative life of one of the twentieth century s great musical geniuses a light in the darkness becomes a stunning tale of how art gets made under even the most challenging circumstances
