In 2007 the United Nations adopted a Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples including their rights to self-determination and to protect their cultures, identities, languages, ceremonies, and access to employment, health, and education. Indigenous peoples are distinct social and cultural groups that share collective ancestral ties to the lands and natural resources where they live, occupy, or from which they have been displaced. Indigenous peoples are inheritors and practitioners of unique cultures and ways of relating to people and the environment. They have retained social, cultural, economic, and political structures and knowledge, and they continue to play a vital role in maintaining the diversity of the world's cultural and biological landscape. Many continue to face marginalization, extreme poverty, and other human rights violations through partnerships. UNESCO places the needs of indigenous peoples among its priority areas of response. There are more than 5,000 different indigenous peoples around the world, comprising 476 million people, around 6.2% of the global population. They are spread across more than 90 countries in every region. The United Nations adopted the International Day of the World's Indigenous Peoples on September 9, 2009. The United Nations also established the Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues in 2000. While the rights of indigenous peoples have been progressively given more attention by the UN system, yet indigenous peoples continue to be left behind and suffer disproportionately from climate change, environmental degradation, high levels of poverty, poor access to education, health, and broader human rights violations.
