and summative tests formal assessment should guide major educational decisions about student and program success formal assessment uses formal tests or structured continuous assessment to evaluate a learner s level of language it can be compared to informal assessment which involves observing the learners performance as they learn and evaluating them from the data gathered example phonic elements portfolios most of the assessments here should be given one on one it is important that you have a non distracting comfortable testing environment for students and that the rest of the class is engaged in a task or assignment and working quietly two of the primary methods are formal and informal assessments formal assessments include tests quizzes and projects students can study and prepare for these assessments in advance and they provide a systematic tool for teachers to measure a student s knowledge and evaluate learning progress
